HISTORY:

Joygram Social Welfare Society is established in the year 2012 by an initiative of a group of Teacher's, social workers and officers some of whom are disable, orphan, education, health with an objective up lift the lives of marginalized section of society.

As we the society works in free surgical operation like – any type of surgical operation below 14 years of age. Surgical operation for all age groups as eye testing, joining abnormal lips (thotkata), Surgery of inner portion of the mouth (Tagrakata), artificial limbs and hand installation etc . To perform all the social works easily we require on medical van in this regard.

The drinking water of Hasnabad area is salty and full of arsenic. Those who have money are surviving by buying drinking waters. But who have not are being forced to drink the poison and slowly slowly going tow-ards death. We have Ichamati river with plenty of water is it. If one water treatment will be established there, it will be very helpful for the poor people.

From last few month we JSWS workers already started free coaching classes for the poor under privi- leged and orphan students of there area. Also we have already taken all responsibilities to fulfill all needs of four (4) girls child from feeding, clothing to education and marriage. But the problem is we have no permission as soon as we get it, we will continue the social work towards giving shelter the orphan people.

Now started disable school at area because no disable school under 30 K.M. center around. This society is running 130 self help group.

VISION:

To Promote a society in which everybody including orphan, disable(education-home based, institution based, aids & appliances distribution and health related activities) , SC/ST/OBC/Minority SHG, students and poor, marginalized and disadvantage communities have equal opportunities and facilities and work to their potential and be self reliant with justice, equity and pride.

Enhancing the life Standard in quantitative and quantitative terms so as to integrate the marginalized and vulnerable section and help them to participate in the mainstream society.

- Empowerment of marginalized and disadvantaged groups and strengthening efforts to build self – reliance and to bring them to the mainstream of society.
- To promote the development of children, dropout children, women, orphan, disable persons SHG and backward communities.
- To promote their participation in education, health care and economic activities.
- To promote awareness and education for the target communities.
- To promote awareness for cultivation, Agriculture, Self Help for the target area and community.
- Tiger widows women development (Kalitala G.p , Hingalgang Block).
- Health Checkup Camp & Tele Medicine.
- Vocational Training (Disable & Normal).

Sustainable community based initiative for development of the target groups through education, health, SHG, cultivation, Agriculture, economic, social development efforts, sewing machine support for tiger widow, Financial literacy.

The organizations focus has been focused in all over West Bengal while its presence is also there in Basirhat Sub Division. The working area is a deliberate selection keeping the geographic, social economic situation beside the presence of the target communities in those areas. (activities based on whole west Bengal for child operation related issues.)

CAPACITIES OF THE ORGANISATION:

As a pioneering organization in communities based activities working in District of North 24 Parganas Basirhat Sub Division. JSWS has committed manpower, capacities and experience of taking up preventive and care activities on through health checkup camp, children operation and HIV/AIDS, relativity with community for the areas covered on its CSR sector.



PRESENT ACTIVITIES:

A: community based inclusive education for disable children:

Inclusive education programme for 50 children with disabilities is being implemented in about 20 villages In Hasnabad, Hingalganj, sandeshkhali, Basirhat block area with support for pre school and at school education of disabled children, capacity building of the teachers, adoptive material for disabled children and community mobilization.

B: Free Coaching Class:

From last Few years we JSWS workers already started free coaching classes for the school dropout children, poor and orphan students of there area. Now number of students 80. Also we have already taken all responsibility to fulfill all needs of four (4) girls child from feeding, clothing to education and marriage and we have support 23 orphan children regularly (per month) as possible.

C: Operation:

As we the society works in free surgical operation like any type of surgical operation below 14 years of age. Surgical operation for all all age groups as eye testing, contract operation. Joining abnormal lips (Thotkata) surgery of inner portion of the mouth (Tagrakata), surgery of appendicitis, tumour, heart and artificial limbs and hands installation etc.

D: SELF HELP Group in 30 Villages:

Self Help Group of women have been formed in 30 Village and additionally 15 groups have been formed in patlikhanpur G.P and Rupamari G.P. urban areas in association with Nabard and N.Y.K project of patlikhanpur Gram Panchayet.

E. Income Generation Training for Disabled Persons and Women:

Vocational training are given for disabled persons and women in various traders like Tailoring Basket making etc.

F: Medical Camp and Health care Programmes:

Availability of sophisticated medical equipment and valuable medicines from our organization to conduct regular medical camps in rural remote village covering 300-350 persons in each camp and free of cost.

G: Project Monitoring and Evulation (PME) System:

Monitoring is a regular exercise in which staff and the target groups has well defined role and participation. Monitoring includes maintainance of client profile and records by client and his family while at office by respective field staff.

H: Training / Workshop Conducted by JSWS:

Income generation – Tailoring training – trough expert Mr. Alauddin.

Poultry observe training – Trough Expert Mr. Niresh kumar Baidya.

In – service teachers workshop for orientation & mobility.

I: Community Based Rehabilitation:

We have CBR Programme in 20 village in 5 Gram Panchayet, 5 Teachers have have been kept to do this

J. DISABLE EDUCATION .

a/ Institution Based Education - in current status more than 70 students are studying .

b/ Home Based Education- Activitie based on the areas of Hasnabad and Hingolgun blocks (G.P areas) and several villages in a multiple basis.

K. Health- checkup and Telemedicine :-

- a/ Monthly Health-Checkup Camps and absolutely Free Medicines support on need basis according to the diagnosis of diseases (specially for sugar & pressure patients).
- b/ We the organization give the support on advanced world renowned Tele-Medicine technology with advanced interaction in between through patients and expert Physicians/ Doctors at a same time from another location of Arogya Vahini Trust (Kolkata) with a active support on diagnosis of several diseases according to the disease natures of patients at a glance.
- c/ Albendazole and Vitamin supplements support for poor needy children's and women's in local area basis of all communities { Vitamin A supplement – Oral Liquid Preparation (USP), Vitamin – Mineral Supplement for parental women's, Albendazole Tablets (IP 400 mg) }
